Internet Safety

Yolo which stands for 'you only live once' is an anonymous question and answer app that is used within Snapchat. Users can post anonymous questions and comments on a Snapchat story and also attach an image. Once you have linked the app to a Snapchat account, it prompts you to 'get anonymous messages' and create a question to prompt others to 'Send me honest messages'. Responses to questions are only seen by the person who asked the question rather than other users on the platform. The app has changed its age rating to 18 and over and like other anonymous apps before it, this feature on Yolo could encourage users to send malicious messages or create incidents of cyberbullying which parents should be aware of.
