We will be resuming the national statutory assessments this year. These are:

Reception baseline assessment

Year 1 phonics screening check (Summer term)

Year 2 phonics screening check (Autumn term)

Year 2(End of Key stage 1) teacher assessments

Year 4 multiplication tables check

Year 6 (End of Key Stage 2) SATs test for:

- Grammar, punctuation and Spelling
- Reading
- Maths
- Teacher assessment for writing

We will be holding meetings at the start of the Spring term to explain how these work and how you can support your child.
