#### TikTok checklist

You may be aware that TikTok is a social media app that lets subscribers create, share and view other users 60 second videos. The official age rating for the app is 13 and above but users do not have to prove their age when creating an account, so younger children can still use it quite easily. It's most popular with under-16s. SWGfL and the UK Safer Internet Centre in collaboration with TikTok has created a checklist which provides information about the app and how to stay safe.
