

School Uniform Information

Thank you for supporting with our school uniform. We are proud that the children look smart and represent our school community.

If your child has a specific reason why they are unable to follow the uniform policy, then please let us know – any conversation will be in confidence. There may be financial or medical reasons and we are always happy to offer support or advice where we can.

*Required items are listed in bold below

Ties

KS1 will have ties on elastic for ease of use and KS2 children will have ties which they will tie themselves. These are optional in Reception, but required from KS1. All children are given one tie for free when joining the school.

<u>PE</u>

Children should bring their PE kit in a drawstring bag to hang on a peg (due to limited space). This kit should be in school every day. Long hair should always be tied back for safety reasons.

<u>Jewellry</u>

Children are allowed to wear watches, but we do not accept responsibility for loss or damage. Jewellery should not be worn as it can be a source of danger, but if your child does have pierced ears, one small stud in each ear is acceptable. Jewellery, including earrings, must be removed for PE and games lessons. It is better if no jewellery is worn because it is safer and cannot be lost.

Appearance

Nail varnish, make-up and body art are not appropriate in school.

Technology

We do not permit pupils to have mobile telephones, smart watches or any other electronic gadgets in school.

It is advisable for parents to 'shop around' for school uniform items as many can be reasonably priced in department stores, online, in supermarkets or charity shops.
